New York Hedge Fund Roundtable Announces Formation of Management Committee and Engagement of Association Management Firm

Additionally, the Roundtable recently engaged an association management firm to assume the day-to-day administrative and operational functions of the Roundtable so that the Management Committee may spend more time focused on strategic initiatives relating to its mission of thought leadership, education, and best practices in the alternative investment fund community.

“Transitioning the Roundtable’s administrative responsibilities will enable our Board of Directors and our newly-formed Management Committee to focus on the Roundtable’s mission of education and best practices in the alternative investment industry and to continue to host outstanding monthly events,” said Tim Selby, President of the Roundtable.
