The New York Hedge Fund Roundtable developed out of a series of discussions led by Stanley Goldstein and others in the alternative investment space over the past five years. Today, under the leadership of Timothy Selby, the membership list has grown to over 1,000 people. Attendance at each monthly breakfast meeting is generally limited to 50 - 60 people, to enable effective discussion regarding industry developments and best practices. Special events on key industry themes are held throughout the year for larger groups of attendees. Members include hedge fund professionals, investors and professional service firms catering to the alternative investment industry.

The New York Hedge Fund Roundtable was founded on three governing principles:

1. Continuously educating roundtable members from the investing and hedge fund worlds on relevant industry topics and forecasts
2. Endorsing best practices and facilitating knowledge transfer to the broader hedge fund world, allowing members to leverage peer information exchange and positively affecting both the profession and others
